PROGRAM STATISTICS

- **98%** of parents said that their children were often or sometimes able to eat healthier, more balanced meals than before the Sack Summer Hunger program.
- **99%** of parents said that their children often or sometimes liked the food provided through the program.
- **96%** of parents and children said they learned more about healthy nutrition and the MyPlate food model.
- **92%** of parents said their children were able to consume three or more servings of fruits and vegetables each week.




